



A Bar in the Folies-Bergère 2015 monofilament, nail, pin 20 X 20 X 20 inches


A fishing wire reveals its utility only by concealing its physical presence. That is how it fools a fish to its death. A wire's transparency obscures its physical presence, but consolidates its existence. In the installation, the wire takes on an alternate identity. The cube formed by the wires is present to our eyes, but lacks physical existence. The red bar going through the cube is also present only as an illusion. The woman in Manet's *A Bar at Folies-Bergère* has dominant presence in the painted space, but the impossible reflection on the mirror questions her existence. Perhaps, the space exists only as a construct of her mind in the same way the perceived cube and the bar are only our mental constructs.





Mask 2014 paper 12 X 8 X 4 inches The pattern on the mask is made by plotting numerical data of the photographs I have taken in a three dimensional space.





Ivy Stone 2017

resin(proposed) 8 X 4 X 4 inches each Every year in May, the University of Pennsylvania creates an Ivy Stone for the graduating class. The proposed installation requires the removal of four brick blocks from a campus building, contrary to the usual practice of covering up an existing structure by gluing a stone onto it.


The "stones" integrate into the surrounding architecture rather than being glued onto it. The transparency of the resin captures and reflects the ambient light that shifts the appearance of the stones according to external conditions. The stones continue to interact with its surroundings, breathing with the landscape. The words and the patterns are never stationary, but are constantly reshaped.




